6. **Insurance.** It is a condition of entry that clubs and competitors must take out their own third-party insurance cover. Where Henley Royal Regatta is involved with providing boats for competitors or acts as an introducer, unless expressly stated in writing to the contrary, clubs and competitors will be responsible for insuring such craft on an All Risks basis including Henley Royal Regatta as a joint insured under the relevant insurance policy.

7. **Safety Requirements.** It is a condition of entry that all competitors must be able to swim a minimum of 100 yards in light clothing and shoes. All coxswains competing at the Regatta shall wear suitable life-jackets or buoyancy aids at all times when on the water (Rule 27(f)).

8. **Coxswains' Experience.** It is a condition of entry that the Club Official who signs the Entry Form on behalf of the Coxswain of a crew must have ascertained the competency of the Coxswain (particularly of a young Coxswain) in accordance with the Guidelines of their National Federation.

9. **Traffic Rules.** It is a condition of entry that all competitors must comply with and abide by the traffic rules on the water as defined in the document "Traffic Rules and Training Times" and also any instructions given from time to time by the Environment Agency. A copy of this document will be available to download from the Regatta website ([www.hrr.co.uk](http://www.hrr.co.uk)).

10. **Advertising Rules.** It is a condition of entry that all competitors must comply with and abide by the Rules for Advertising as defined in the document "Notes and Instructions for Competitors and Coaches". A copy of this document will be available to download from the Regatta website ([www.hrr.co.uk](http://www.hrr.co.uk)).

11. **Accommodation, Boats and Transport.** The Regatta Committee does not provide accommodation, boats or transport for competitors. However, the Secretary may be able to assist by suggesting possible contacts if requests are made to him in sufficient time. It is emphasised that there is only a limited number of suitable boats available for loan or hire, and competitors who cannot bring their own boats are strongly advised to make their own arrangements in good time. The Regatta Committee accepts no responsibility for providing boats; and any assistance given by the Secretary is limited to an introduction between the parties concerned.

12. **Entry Fees.** Entry fees must accompany the Entry Form and are:-  
For all Events for Eights ..... £100.00  
For all Events for Fours  
and for Quadruple Sculls ..... £60.00  
For The Silver Goblets  
and for The Double Sculls ..... £40.00  
For The Diamond Challenge Sculls  
and for The Princess Royal Challenge Cup ..... £30.00

For entries from outside the United Kingdom this fee must be paid in Sterling, Sterling Draft or Sterling Travellers' Cheques (not Eurocheques), or by Visa or MasterCard using the enclosed yellow form.

13. **Contact Details.** In order that the Secretary of the Regatta can contact a representative of a crew in an emergency, it is essential that the telephone numbers, mobile telephone numbers and email addresses required on the Entry Form are completed accurately.

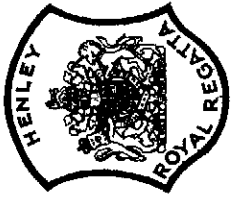
## ENTRY FORM AND DECLARATION

### IMPORTANT

The closing date for entries is **2.00 p.m. (1400 hours) on Tuesday 17th June.** **Rule 3**

The Entry Form, complete in all respects, together with the appropriate entry fees, must be received by the Secretary of the Regatta by that time. **Rule 4**

- 1. Entry Form.** Entries must be made on the Entry Form accompanying this information sheet. Entries submitted on any other type of form will not be accepted. The receipt of an Entry Form at Regatta Headquarters will be acknowledged by email to the email address provided on the completed Entry Form.
- 2. Regatta Rules.** All entries shall be made in accordance with the current Qualification Rules and General Rules of Henley Royal Regatta, of which copies are enclosed.  
**All competitors and Club Officials are strongly advised to read the provisions of these Rules with great care.**
- 3. Composite Crews.** See General Rules 7 and 15. Any entry for a composite crew must be made on a separate Entry Form.
- 4. Double Entries.** No competitor (coxswains excepted) may be entered for more than two events. The Committee will try to accommodate the preferences of the competitors who are doubling up as to the order of their races. However, if an irreconcilable conflict of interest occurs, the Committee may decide to adopt the following order of priority to determine the order in which the events will be rowed:  
**8; 4-; 4+; 4Sc; 2-; 2Sc; 2Sc.**  
(Double entries will only be accepted on this understanding)
- 5. Qualification Races.** If Qualifying Races are necessary (see Rule 19) they will take the form of Timed Races and will be held on the afternoon and evening of Friday, 27th June. Overseas crews entering **The Remenham, The Thames, The Temple, The Princess Grace, The Prince of Wales, The Fawley, The Visitors', The Wyfold, The Britannia, The Prince Albert, The Silver Goblets, The Double Sculls, The Princess Royal Challenge Cups or The Diamond Challenge Sculls are reminded that they may be required to row in these Qualifying Races.**  
**NEW** If a crew is required to compete in the Qualifying Races then its name will be included on a list that will appear on the Regatta website ([www.hrr.co.uk](http://www.hrr.co.uk)) on the evening of Sunday, 22nd June. This list will show the start times of all the various events in the Qualifying Races. In addition, there will be information sheets on the website giving instructions on arrival - parking - rigging - boating - the Start - Traffic Rules - bicycles - results - departure.  
This information will not be posted to Clubs, it will only be available on the website. It is the responsibility of all crews to check the website to see if they are required to take part in the Qualifying Races and then to fully familiarise themselves with all the relevant instructions and guidance displayed on the website.  
In the case of adverse weather/river conditions, all crews should monitor the Regatta website in the days leading up to the Qualifying Races to check whether there has been any postponement or change to the timing of this event.

### HENLEY ROYAL REGATTA 2008

Please find enclosed copies of the Entry Form for this year's Regatta which will be held over five days from Wednesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> to Sunday, 6<sup>th</sup> July inclusive.

Also enclosed are copies of the Constitution and Rules of the Regatta and I shall be obliged if you will send these to any club within your Federation which may be considering entering Henley Royal Regatta this year. If you require further copies for your clubs, please let me know as soon as possible.

The closing date for entries is 2.00 p.m. (1400 hours) on Tuesday, 17<sup>th</sup> June and all forms must bear the counter-signature of an official from your Federation. Please ensure that these formalities are completed in good time, as the Regatta invariably rejects late entries.

You need to be aware that the size of the entry in a number of events can lead to the **majority** of crews being required to race in the Qualifiers. Please allow for this in your planning. This year the Qualifying Races will take place on the afternoon/evening of Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> June. The events most likely to be affected are: The Temple, The Thames, The Princess Elizabeth, The Remenham, The Visitors', The Wyfold, The Britannia, The Princess Grace, The Fawley, The Prince Albert and The Prince of Wales Challenge Cups, and the four small boat events.

I shall try to assist with arrangements for accommodation and transportation, provided that requests are made in sufficient time. However, it must be understood that no financial responsibility for the provision of these facilities can be accepted by the Regatta.

The Stewards of the Regatta look forward to receiving entries from clubs of your Federation for this year's Regatta.
