**Rowing Australia and the National Rowing Centre of Excellence, are now opening Expressions of Interest for the positions of:**

- National Selectors (Senior A and Under 23) – 2 positions
- Senior A, Under 23 and Junior Team Managers – 1 position each Team
- Head Coach Elite Adaptive Program – 1 position
- Doctor and Physiotherapist (Senior A, U23 & Junior Teams) – 1 in each team
- Massage Therapist (Senior A) - 1 position

### **National Selector (Senior A and U23)**

- National Selectors (Senior A and Under 23) – 2 positions available. These positions will be added to the Panel consisting of: National High Performance Director and National Head Coaches (Men & Women)
- Candidates sought would preferably have broad rowing experience (either as an athlete or coach), be familiar with current international rowing trends, and have strong analytical skills.
- Additionally they would need appropriate skills to work within a high pressure team environment.
- When you apply, please include a *brief* dot point, one page summary of your experience and qualifications (as related to the Selection of Athletes).

### **Team Manager (U23 and Junior teams)**

The Senior 'A' Manager will be a four (4) year appointment (reviewed annually by the National High Performance Director and other relevant staff). It is planned that the successful nominee will be nominated to the AOC as the 2012 Olympic Rowing Section Manager. Note: A second 'A' Team Manager may be appointed from within NRCE/SIS/SAS staff in any year.

Key characteristics sought for Team Managers are:

- Strong interpersonal and communication skills, the ability to handle sometimes complex and high pressure logistical arrangements.
- International travelling experience, appropriate financial management experience.
- The ability to travel overseas for potentially extended periods of time. Plus a willingness to go the extra mile for athletes and coaches.

- Selection Trials (A/U23 & possibly Juniors 17-26 April)
- Senior A World Championships (tour approx 8/9 Aug – 30 Aug)
- Under 23 World Champs (tour approx 12/13 July – 27/28 July)
- Junior A World Champs (tour approx 26/27 July – 9 Aug)
- NTID Development Tour to NZ (tour approx 20 – 25 May)

### Head Coach (Elite Adaptive Program)

The Head Coach Elite Adaptive Program will be a four (4) year appointment (reviewed annually by the National High Performance Director and other relevant staff). The position will attract a \$15,000pa **honorarium** – and is subject to ongoing APC & NRCE funding levels and priorities remaining unchanged.

### Doctor and Physiotherapist (Senior A, U23 & Junior Teams) & Massage Therapist (Senior A team only)

Expressions of interest are called from suitably qualified individuals for the positions of Team Doctor, Team Physiotherapist & Team Massage Therapist.

- 1 Doctor and 1 Physiotherapist travel with each underage Team (Senior A, U23 and Junior) &
- 1 Massage Therapist with the Senior A team
- Approx dates for touring above

Key characteristics for appointment are:

- The appropriate medical qualifications
- the ability to relate to a wide range of individuals
- the ability to work as part of a team in high pressure situations.
