

2009 Australian Youth Cup

Bulletin 2

The 2009 Australian Youth Cup will be conducted in Sydney from 10th to 12th July 2009 at the Sydney International Regatta Centre (SIRC) in Penrith, NSW. Invitations are extended to all State Rowing Associations and Rowing New Zealand.

Please ensure you read Bulletin 1 for further information.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES

Final entries for the 2009 Australian Youth Cup, including crew seating will close at 5:00pm AEST on Friday, 12 June 2009. All entries must be made via ROMS (Rowing Online Management System).

INDIVIDUAL ATHLETE ENTRIES

The following requirements are to be taken into consideration when making entries:

1. All athletes (with the exception of the coxswain) are to compete in 3 events, that being a small boat (1X, 2-, Lightweight 2X), a big boat (4X, 4-) and the 8+.
2. All teams are to enter two boats in the 1X and 2- (1 in each division) and 1 boat in the remaining events
3. Pursuant to Rowing Australia rules and point 1, there are no restrictions to the selection of individual athletes to specific crews.

ACCOMMODATION

There are a number of events scheduled on the same weekend as the 2009 Australian Youth Cup, this includes national netball, rugby league and rugby union tournaments. Due to the popularity of Penrith at this time, sourcing accommodation at reasonable costs and locations has been very difficult.

All teams have been allocated accommodation for up to 25 people (20 athletes and 5 coaching and support staff). The rooms have been booked for 4 nights; Wednesday 7th July until Saturday 11th July with a departure on Sunday morning. If your team requires an additional night's accommodation on the Sunday 12th July or extra rooms please let Georgie at NSWRA know as soon as possible.

The cost has been equalised to ensure no one team is disadvantaged, the cost will be \$60 per person per night (across 4 nights).

ACCESS TO SYDNEY INTERNATIONAL REGATTA CENTRE

SIRC has been booked for 2 training days (Wednesday 8th and Thursday 9th July) with the regatta commencing on Friday 10th July. Access prior to these times can be arranged directly with SIRC Venue Management though additional fees may apply. Please contact Linda Toomey on 02 4730 0000.

There will be full access to the island for all competitors, trailers and spectators, there will be no requirement for car park passes. Please let Georgie at NSWRA know when your team trailer is likely to arrive to unload your boats.

There is sufficient racking at the venue for all teams boats though you are able to use your trailer if required.

Access to the venue is from 6am until sunset daily.

NOTICE

Please note that due to the cost of running a regatta at SIRC there may be a small fee payable by the athletes. This will not be known until the conclusion of the regatta but may be in the vicinity of \$10-\$20.

EQUIPMENT

It is expected that all Australian States will provide their own boats, however any state with boat difficulties should contact New South Wales Rowing Association immediately. Boats will be provided for the New Zealand team, if any State Association can assist with sourcing boats for this team, please inform the New South Wales Rowing Association. We will endeavor to provide the international teams with the highest quality boats available however it must be noted that these boats will be sourced from local clubs and schools therefore no guarantees can be made regarding the age or quality of boats supplied

The order of events allows boats to double up i.e. on Friday M2- boat can also be W2- or LM2x; on Saturday M4- can also be M4x. This is however subject to change depending on other situation such as weather etc.

TRANSPORT

All teams will organise their own transport to/from the accommodation and airport/train station.

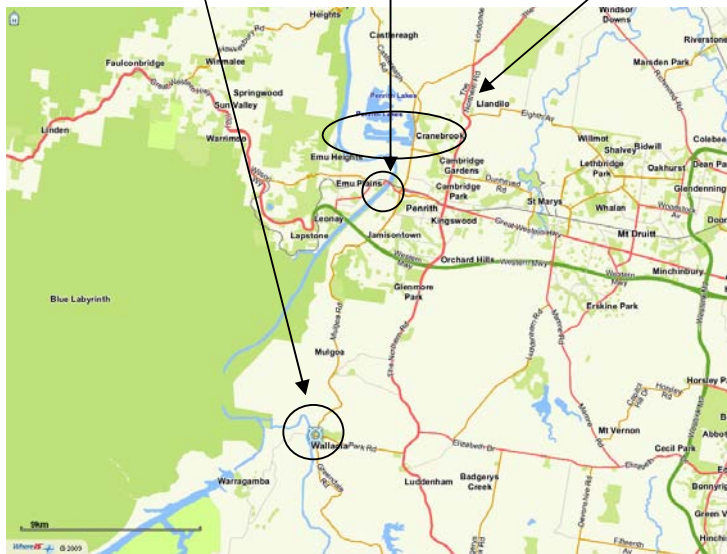

Wallacia Hotel

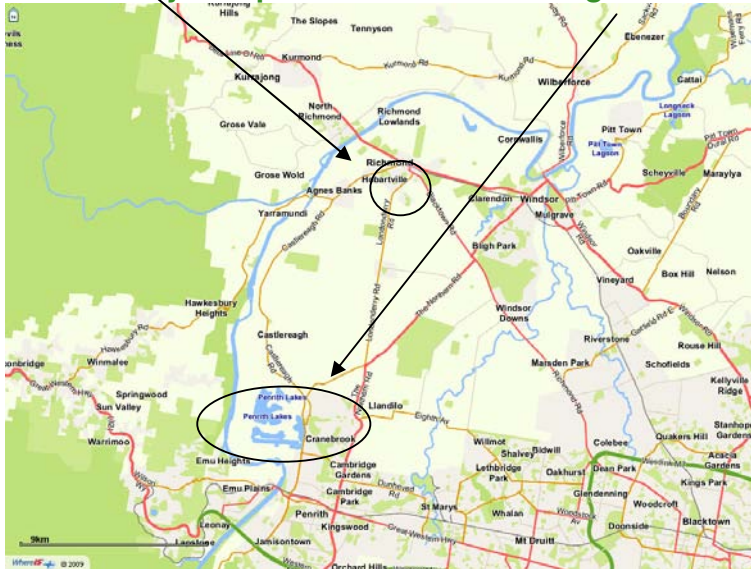
Log Cabin
