Introduction:

Australian University Sport (AUS) has allocated the Rowing Australia National Selectors the responsibility of selecting crews and coaches to represent Australia at the 2010 World University Championships.

Following selection of the athletes and coaches by Rowing Australia all subsequent management, travel planning and financial requirements will be the responsibility of AUS and the selected athletes and coaches.

Location: Szeged, Hungary
Regatta dates: 13-15 August 2010
Age restrictions: Competitors must be born between 1 January 1982 and 31 December 1992
Regatta events: M1x, M2x, M2-, M4-, M8+, LM1x, LM2x, LM4-, W1x, W2x, W4-, LW1x, LW2x

Selection aims:

The selection aims for this event are:

1. Select crews that have demonstrated the ability to competitively represent Australia at the World University Championships
2. Provide international racing experience for developing high performance athletes

Selection Process:

Athletes and coaches will be selected in line with the selection process detailed in the Rowing Australia Selection Policy and the Senior A and Under 23 Event Requirements.

Athletes and coaches who have submitted a nomination form and gained invitation to the April National Selection Trials will be considered for selection into the World University Championships team.
